TRASH & RECYCLING COLLECTION

Trash and recycling will be collected Wednesday, Nov. 11 and there will be no interruption in the regular trash and recycling collection schedule.

WORKFORCE CENTERS

All Denver Workforce Centers will be closed Wednesday, Nov. 11 for the holiday. The City's online hiring system will be available at www.denvergov.org/jobs.

3-1-1, the City's information line for nonemergency services, will be closed Wednesday, Nov.11.

PARKING METERS, PARKING CASHIERS AND PARKING MAGISTRATE

Parking meters will be free on Wednesday, Nov. 11. However, drivers are reminded to observe the time restrictions posted. The Parking Cashier counter and the Parking Magistrate's office in the Wellington E. Webb Building, 201 W. Colfax Ave., will be closed Wednesday.
