1. Overview

This Environmental Lead Requirements Registry details the legal and other requirements (such as Denver Environmental Health policy) that provide guidance for City and County of Denver (CCoD) actions. It is intended to outline these requirements from their source (such as federal guidance documents) to specific documents and actions that must take place in order to meet the requirements (such as reporting and record keeping).

The aspects and impacts to public health from environmental lead are identified in the most recent version of Environmental Aspects and Impacts Assessment.

To address the legal and other requirements created by these aspects, CCoD operates the following program(s):

1. Environmental Lead Program (addresses childhood lead poisoning prevention).

Additionally, CCoD has created and published an Environmental Guideline (EG) to assist in controlling the aspects referenced above to minimize impacts from environmental lead. A list of EGs can be found in the Environmental Guideline Process and Catalog.
