

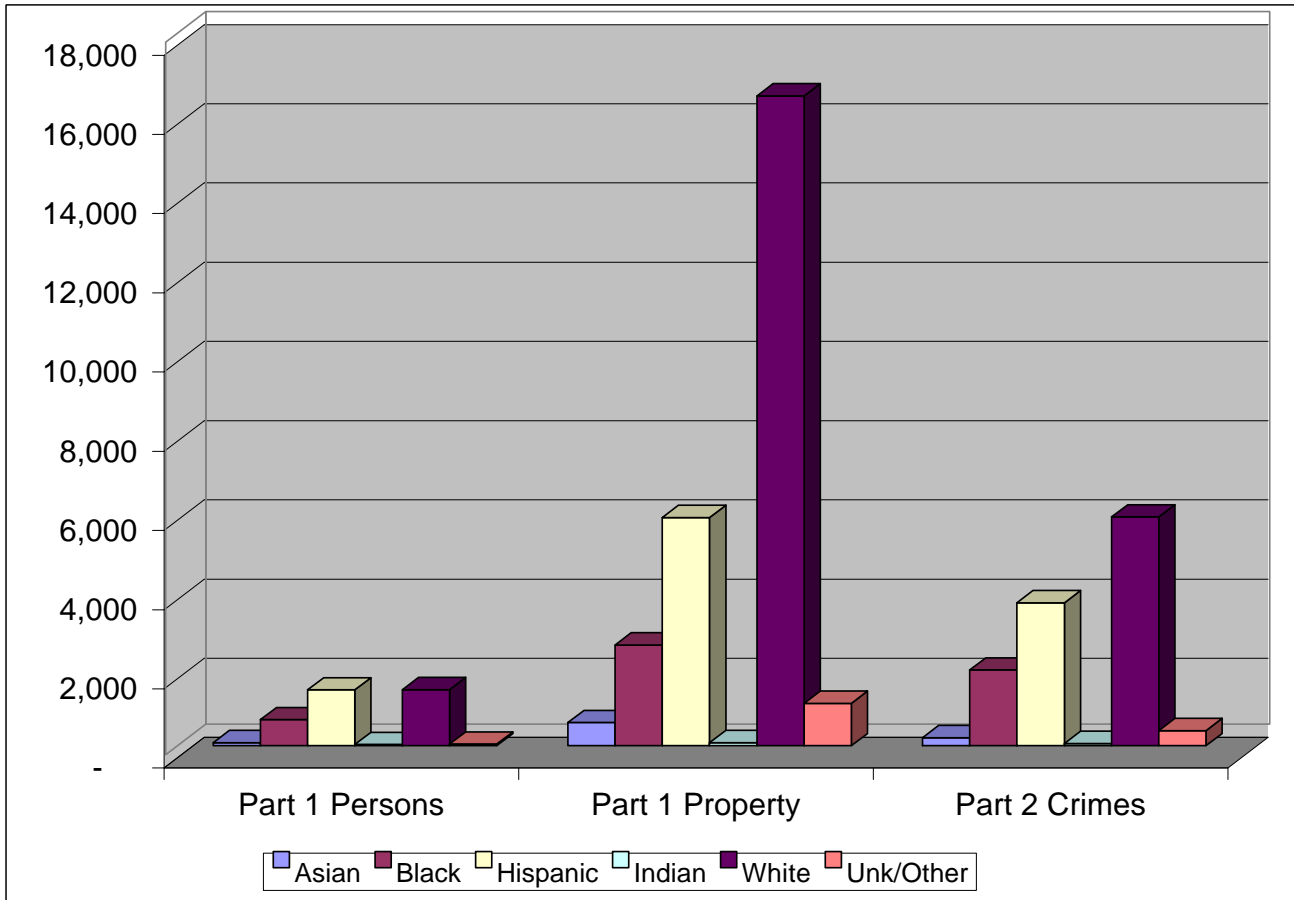

There were 58,683 offense reports filed from June 1, 2002 through May 31, 2003. Although 3,708 reports were unfounded, they were included in our study because if a victim was identified, it was assumed that non-discretionary police contact was made.

There were 40,696 offenses that had listed the victim's gender and/or race. Please note that there may have been more than one victim identified per offense report; therefore, this count is person specific and not offense specific. There were 42,003 victims identified in the 40,696 reports.

Victim data was collected for non-discretionary offense categories. All other offenses not included in the data were determined to be discretionary. A listing of both non-discretionary and discretionary offense follows:
