

NEW STATEWIDE LICENSE PLATE FEE INCREASES

License Plate Late Fees – Begins June 1, 2009

Colorado Senate Bill 09-108, an increase to vehicle registration late fees, will become law on June 1, 2009. The new law requires a late fee assessment of \$25 per month for every month past the grace period (one month) up to a maximum of \$100. This fee is assessed in addition to renewal fees and also applies to temporary permits.

The new late fees apply to expired registrations, temporary permits, and vehicle owners who move to Colorado from out of state and do not register their vehicles within 90 days of residency. *Fees are programmed without override and waiver by agent.

Vehicle Registration Fees – Begins July 1, 2009

In addition to increasing late fees, Senate Bill 09-108 increases the amount of registration fees. Increased fees become effective on July 1, 2009. The table below illustrates the fee increase schedule. Note that the amounts below are in addition to registration fees already assessed:

2,000 lbs & Under	\$22.50	\$25.75	\$29.00
2,001 - 5,000 lbs	\$32.00	\$36.50	\$41.00
5,001 - 16,000 lbs	\$39.50	\$45.25	\$51.00
16,001 lbs and over	\$55.00	\$63.00	\$71.00
