

NOTICE OF CHANGES

(Updated 3/1/02)

In the past, Denver facilities were allowed to submit the Uniform Fire Code (UFC) Hazardous Materials Inventory Statement or HMIS in lieu of the Federal EPCRA Tier Two Report. **Effective January 1, 1999**, facilities covered by both UFC and EPCRA must complete two different inventory reports and send these reports to the following recipients:

- Federal EPCRA Tier Two Reports are due annually by March 1 and must be submitted to designated state and local offices. These offices are listed below.
- The Uniform Fire Code HMIS report is a requirement under local ordinance and these reports must be sent to the Denver Fire Department. This location is listed below.
