


## TIPS FOR PARKING IN DOWNTOWN DENVER

- ◆ Read all signs before leaving your vehicle. Non-metered spaces often have time limit or other restrictions that apply.
- ◆ Meters are meant for short-term parking. If your trip is expected to take more than two hours, plan to park in a garage or parking lot.
- ◆ Park your vehicle within the space provided. At meters this means the bumpers should not extend beyond the meter post.
- ◆ Never park more than 18 inches from any curb; about one and one half shoe lengths.
- ◆ Time limits are posted on all meters. When the time has lapsed your vehicle must be moved to another location (more than 100 feet) or it can be ticketed. Meters are meant for short term visits.
- ◆ Remember to watch the posted enforcement times on meters; signed spaces are enforced 24 hours per day.
- ◆ Don't stay away too long, come back and see us soon.

## "The Key to The City"



## What is the “Key to the City”?



The key is a rechargeable “debit” card that is accepted in every parking meter in Denver. The key will automatically deduct the minimum time required at each meter each time it is inserted into a parking meter. The screen on the meter tells you as each minimum amount is deducted, until you remove it.

### \$ HOW MUCH DOES THE KEY COST?

There is a one time \$15.00 deposit, plus the value of the time you purchase from \$10.00 to \$500.00. The key works the same as cash. You get the deposit back when you return the key. You pay only for the time.

### \$ HOW DO I GET A KEY?

Visit any one of the five convenient key sponsor outlets between 8 am and 5 pm Monday through Friday.

### \$ WHAT’S THE MINIMUM AMOUNT I CAN ADD TO MY KEY?

You can add or refill as much credit to the key as you like; from a minimum of \$10.00 up to \$500.00.

### \$ HOW MUCH DOES THE AVERAGE TWO-HOUR METER COST?

The average cost is \$2.00.

### \$ HOW MUCH IS THE AVERAGE PARKING TICKET?

They may vary from \$20.00 to \$100.00.

### \$ HOW DO I KNOW IF MY KEY IS RUNNING LOW?

Each time you inset the key into a meter, the meter display will tell you the balance remaining on your key.

### \$ HOW DO I PAY FOR THE KEY?

- ◆ Cash
- ◆ MasterCard or Visa
- ◆ *(NOTE: some “key to the city” outlets may not accept credit cards)*
- ◆ Cashier Check, Business Check

### \$ PAY ONLY FOR THE TIME YOU NEED!

The key deducts only the amount necessary to park, within 15 minutes.

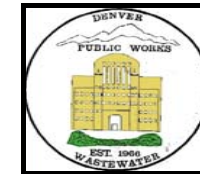
