

**Department of Public Works
Wastewater Management Division
Erosion and Sediment Control Permit Fees
Effective August 1, 2003**

The City and County of Denver, Wastewater Management Division (WMD), issues Construction Activities Stormwater Discharge Permits (CASDP) as required by Federal and State clean water regulations and statutes. Contractors and developers should note that this CASDP is required in addition to any similar permits issued by the State of Colorado under its Colorado Discharge Permit System. This Notice outlines upcoming changes to our CASDP fees. These changes are being implemented to streamline the CASDP inspection billing process.

As authorized by Section 2-91 et seq. and Chapter 27 of the Revised Municipal Code of the City and County of Denver "Governing Sewage Charges and Fees and Management of Wastewater, the following schedules of fees is hereby established. These changes are in accordance with Sections 10.06 and 10.17 of the aforementioned code outlining Water Quality, Grading and Erosion Control activities within the City and County of Denver.

This schedule is effective on August 1, 2003 and supercedes any fee schedule established prior to this date. As of this date, WMD will be charging an up-front \$200.00 plus \$25.00 per acre fee for all sites requiring a CASDP. WMD will collect the new fee at issuance of the CASDP. This fees structure replaces the current \$55.00 per inspection billing practice.
