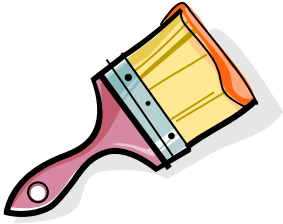


Thank you for your interest in learning how you can help prevent graffiti in Denver. Below are some easy things you can do to keep your property and your community graffiti free.

"THE BRUSH OFF"

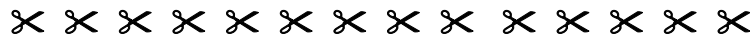
- Request [free paint](#) and promptly remove graffiti from your property.
- Request [free assistance](#) to remove the graffiti you cannot remove or access.
- Request [free paint](#) to cover graffiti in your neighborhood.
- [Report all graffiti](#) vandalism in your community.
- Make your property less attractive to graffiti vandals.



- **Plant short shrubs & prickly plants around your property**
- **Plant vines and climbing plants along fences and walls**
- **Trim shrubs and weeds - remove items that might create hiding places**
- **Secure gates, repair fences & relocate items that intruders can use to scale fences and walls**
- **Install outdoor lighting - consider lights that come on when they sense movement**
- **Apply protective sealer to make graffiti cleanup quicker and easier**
