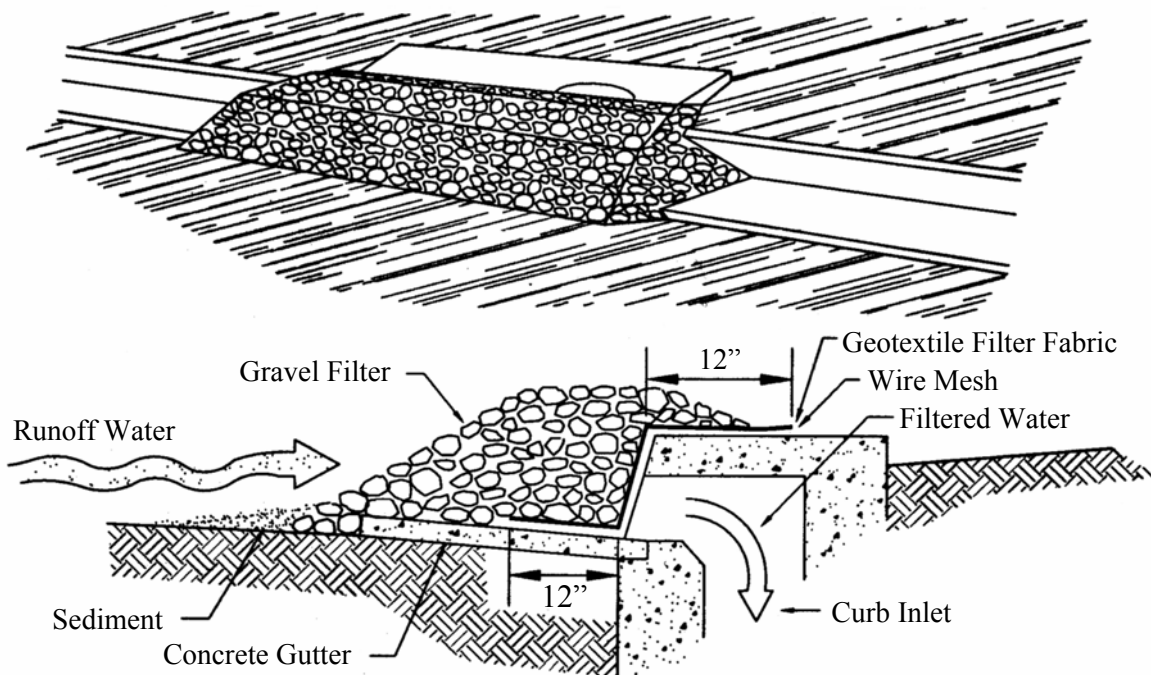


4. Curb Inlet Protection

Definition: A sediment filter or an excavated impounding area around a storm drain or curb inlet.

Purposes: To reduce sediment from entering storm drainage systems prior to permanent stabilization of disturbed area.



Special Application

This method of inlet protection is applicable at curb inlets where ponding in front of the structure is not likely to cause inconvenience or damage to adjacent structures and unprotected areas..

Note: Alternate design could utilize gravel filled bags.
