## Restroom Master Plan Update

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### Better Denver Bond Projects- Implementation of the Restroom Master Plan 2005

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Denver Parks and Recreation is pleased to announce that **Sloan's Lake Park North** is slated to receive a new restroom that was funded by the bond vote last fall. The bond funded all the restrooms identified in the Restroom Master Plan 2005. This plan was reviewed and endorsed by Denver City Council.

The location for the restroom will follow the recommendations of the Sloan's Lake Park Master Plan, 2002. The attractive, functional and durable building design is prototypical based on the design guidelines developed for the master plan.

Four of these restrooms have already been built within Denver Parks with a fifth starting construction in spring. Lessons learned from the first four have been incorporated in the final prototypical building. Sustainable practices following the initiative of *Greenprint Denver* are incorporated as appropriate.

Site design will occur this year and construction is schedule for next year. The restroom building cost is budgeted at \$230,000 and site development and utilities are projected to be about \$60,000.
