

## FAQ's pertaining to permitting for the Democratic National Convention 2008

Q. Who do I contact if I am interested in vending during the week of the convention?

A. Please contact Jenny Morris at (720) 865-2750 or [Jenny.Morris@denvergov.org](mailto:Jenny.Morris@denvergov.org). Unfortunately at this time there are only spots for peddlers. A peddler is a person who may sell items and goods at public events. All goods and/or products must be carried on individual peddler's person and may not be carried, displayed, or stored in or on any carts, dollies, tables, wagons or similar devices. A peddler must be on the move at all times unless making a sale.

Q. Who do I contact for Media Badges?

Q. How do I obtain a parade permit?

In the left hand column you will see a "DNC Designated Parade Route Request" and a "DNC Alternated Parade Route Application." Parades are Monday through Wednesday between 11-3.
