New Denver elections website to inform voters **Reorganized website a key component of "Denver Votes" voter education initiative**

(Denver) – Denver voters now have a significantly improved online source of voting information. The Denver Elections Division has launched its new website: www.denvervotes.org. The website provides a wealth of information at the click of a mouse.

www.denvervotes.org has a clean, crisp look and is much easier to navigate than the old site. It also features a new graphic look that prominently features the "Denver Votes" logo.

Some of the links and information prominently featured on the main page of new site include how to register to vote, how to become a poll worker, links to Elections Director Michael Scarpello's web column on elections preparations, critical dates and deadlines, and forms for requesting mail-in ballots. It also explains how Denver citizens can choose in 2008 between a mail-in ballot, early voting or voting at precinct polling places on Election Day. In coming weeks, the site will provide information to voters needing to look up their precinct polling places.

"This newly enhanced website is a major piece of our "Denver Votes" initiative to improve voter education and outreach," said Denver Clerk and Recorder Stephanie O'Malley. "In this important election year, it is crucial that voters are informed about how they can vote, where they can vote, how to register, and all the other important information that an informed electorate requires. I think this site will prove to be a great online tool for Denver's voters."

In addition to voter information, the site also offers information and tools needed by candidate and issue campaigns, along with historical statistical information on past elections, maps, and announcements of upcoming events.
