Denver to Offer Drive-Through Ballot Drop-off Popular Election Day voting method to continue at new facility

(Denver) – Denver voters will have the convenience of dropping off their mail-in ballot on Election Day, Tuesday, August 12 using a drive-through lane adjacent to the new Denver Elections Division headquarters, at 3888 East Mexico Avenue.

The Elections Division is located 1 block north and one block west of the I-25 and Colorado Blvd. interchange. Note that prior drive-through election service was held downtown and this year it will be at a different location. The drive-through lane will be located on the north side of E. Mexico Avenue, one block west of Colorado Boulevard.

Voters wishing to use the drop off lane should turn west from the intersection of Colorado Boulevard and Mexico Ave. and stay in the far right lane. The secure ballot box will be staffed by a team of poll workers.

The drive-through lane is available on Election Day only and will be open from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m.

For the first time, Denver voters will also have the added convenience of being able to drop off their mail-in ballots at any one of Denver's 186 precinct polling locations on Election Day, but the Elections Division will be the only drive-through.
