Drive it and Drop it!

Mexico Ave. drive through ballot drop-off lane will be open on Saturday, November 1

(Denver) – Denver voters will have the added convenience of being able to drop off their mail ballots at the drive-through drop-off lane in front of the Denver Elections Division this Saturday, November 1.

The Elections Division is located at 3888 E. Mexico Ave. The drive-through lane will be open from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. and is accessible from both eastbound and the westbound on Mexico.

The drive through is staffed by sworn election judges and guarded by a Denver Police officer at all times.

With an unprecedented 196,000-plus Denver voters having requested mail-in ballots, the Elections Division wants to maximize the opportunity for voters to return them.

Mail-in ballots may also be dropped on Monday, November 3 at any of the 13 former early voting locations, although there is no early voting on that day. Mail-in ballots may also be dropped off on Election Day, November 4, at any of 185 precinct polling places.
