Statement from Denver Clerk and Recorder Stephanie O'Malley on Mail Ballot Delivery To Voters

“The Denver Elections Division has received more than 180,000 requests for mail-in ballots this year. The processing of these applications is current and ballots will continue to be sent out in batches. 180,000 ballots is an unprecedented number of mail ballots. The next big batch, about 23,000, is scheduled to go into the mail this Friday.

“We have had voters show up to early vote at early voting locations even though they have requested mail-in ballots. Those voters made requests to cast provisional ballots. I understand the heightened interest in this election, but I respectfully ask the voters of the City of Denver to please be patient and to give their mail-in ballots a chance to get to them.

“Voters who applied for a mail-in ballot prior to October and have not received them yet may call 311 to request a replacement. However, voters who applied for a mail-in ballot in October should wait until October 28 before calling.”
