### **Voting Information Booklet Mailed to Denver Voters This Week TABOR mailer will also contain important voter education information**

(Denver) – Denver voters will receive their Denver TABOR (Taxpayers Bill of Rights) notices in the mail over the next few days. The Denver TABOR book is NOT the state “blue book” but is a separate Denver-only TABOR booklet containing mandated information about the Denver Public Schools’ bond issue. It also has a lot of information voters can use to prepare for a very long ballot and an anticipated record voter turnout. The booklet is being mailed to all Denver households where at least one registered voter resides.

In addition to the required TABOR information the booklet also includes:

- ◆ Information on the three options for voting in Denver: vote by mail, vote early at any of 13 early voting locations, or vote at your assigned polling place on Election Day.
- ◆ An application for mail-in ballot status. By law, any election mailing must contain a mail-in ballot application, but voters who have already applied for mail-in ballot status do NOT need to send in another application.
- ◆ Acceptable forms of identification for voting.
- ◆ A sample ballot showing all Denver County races.

An innovative addition to this year’s booklet is the inclusion of a “Voting Reminder Sheet.” This is a tear-out sheet listing all races and ballot initiatives that voters can tear out, mark up with their voting choices, and bring with them to their polling place to refer to as they mark their official ballot. Because of the length of this year’s ballot, it is hoped that the Voting Reminder Sheet will help expedite the amount of time it takes to vote, and help keep down any lines that may form at polling places.
