Below is the order of the November 5, 2013 ballot per state law and regulations. The Government and Finance Committee needs to decide the order of the three Denver City Charter questions in yellow. All other ballot order questions are predetermined as noted.

1. Candidates

School board members will be elected November 5, 2013. Candidates who have filed so far are Michael Kiley and Barbara O'Brien for At Large, Rosario CdeBaca and Rosemary Rodriquez in District 2, Mike Johnson and Meg Schomp in District 3, and Roger Kilgore and Landri Taylor in District 4. (Candidates have until August 30, 2013 to file.)

State School tax increase proposal, if signatures are approved.
