“Loss and grief can be life-altering, especially for young people. Their every decision about themselves and their world is impacted. It’s important that they and their support teams have guidance through the emotional confusion that happens when dealing with death. My contribution to **Judi’s House** helps serve youth dealing with death, and their guardians, free of charge. When my sister passed away it was one of the hardest things I’ve ever had to go through. The impact on her children and mine was a serious concern, as I had worked hard to help my family members be good, productive citizens and I wanted the best for them. Her death put all of that work at risk. I’m not sure how they felt about it at the time, but I signed up my niece (now my daughter), my sons and myself to get some support. We went once a week to Judi’s House and had a free dinner with other participants and mingled a bit. Then the kids went off for the youth group and I attended the adult group. I’m thankful for the information we received, the time we shared with others and the fact that, even now, my kids can call and get support because of their earlier participation.

“I also support the efforts of **Denver Metro Partners**. This group helps our community by assuring youth have support via mentoring and gang intervention. Youth in our community deal with a wide range of issues that span from latchkey children to parents in prison. It is imperative that there are agencies that can help youth transition into adulthood with a sense of community so they can be a productive citizen. I was introduced to this agency while serving in AmeriCorps Metro Denver Gang Coalition. The education and support I received from them and GRASP helped to transition our family’s future from one of potential death or incarceration to that where my children are gainfully employed and working towards the American dream.

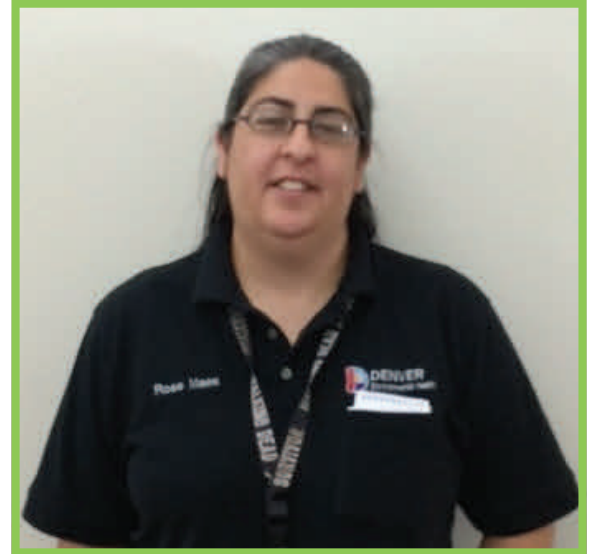
