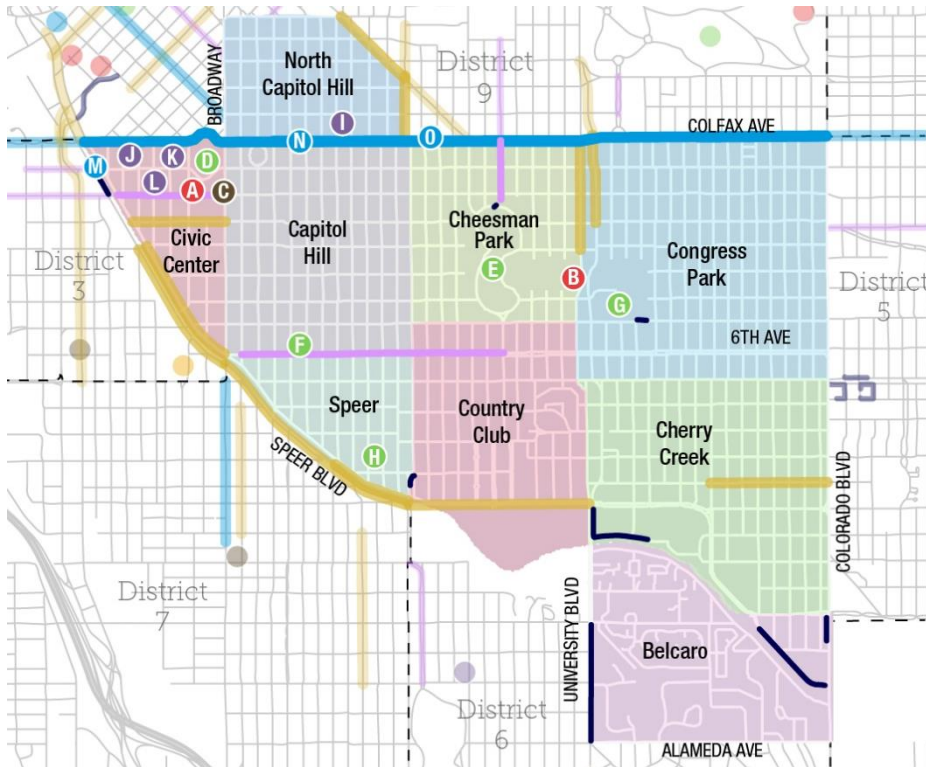


ELEVATE DENVER BOND PROGRAM COUNCIL DISTRICT 10 PROJECTS

Current Status	Project Name and Description
A Construction	Denver Art Museum: Renovate North Building and south structure with a new Welcome Center
B Construction	Denver Botanic Gardens: Construct new Science, Art and Education Center
C Development	Central Library: Address safety and security issues, deferred maintenance, and renovate space
D Development	Civic Center Greek Theater: Improvements to accommodate an outdoor performance space
E Development	Cheesman Neighborhood Park: Upgrade asphalt paths to concrete and replace picnic sites
F Development	Governors' Neighborhood Park: Replace aging playground equipment
G Development	Congress Neighborhood Park: Upgrade asphalt paths to concrete, replace picnic sites, and reconstruct pool
H Development	Alamo-Placita Neighborhood Park: Replace the picnic sites and basketball courts
I Development	Police Station District 6: Construction of a new police station to serve the community
J Development	Lindsey Flanagan Courthouse: Address deferred maintenance
K Development	City and County of Denver Building: Address deferred maintenance
L Development	Police Department Administration Building and Crime Lab: Address deferred maintenance
M Design	14th Avenue Bridge Over Cherry Creek: Replace the bridge
N Development	Colfax Bus Rapid Transit (BRT): Add exclusive bus lanes, new transit stops, and other improvements to allow the BRT to operate efficiently and effectively
O Development	Colfax Corridor Improvements: Improve pedestrian and bicycle safety
