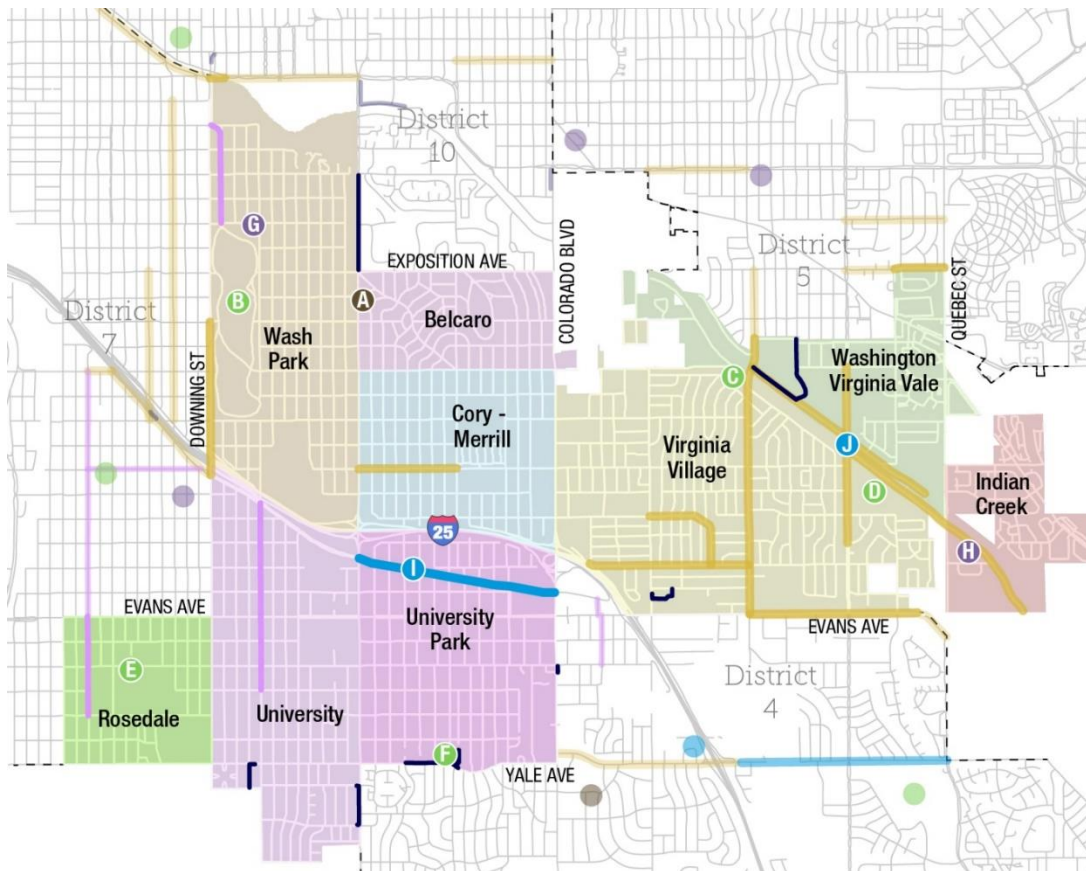


ELEVATE DENVER BOND PROGRAM COUNCIL DISTRICT 6 PROJECTS

A <i>Development</i>	Eugene Field Branch Library: Replace outdated equipment and renovate space
B <i>Development</i>	Washington Neighborhood Park and Recreation Center: Upgrade asphalt paths to concrete, replace picnic areas, and address recreation center deferred maintenance
C <i>Development</i>	Potenza Neighborhood Park: Replace aging playground equipment
D <i>Development</i>	Cook Neighborhood Park and Recreation Center: Upgrade asphalt paths to concrete and address recreation center deferred maintenance
E <i>Development</i>	Harvard Gulch Neighborhood Park and Recreation Center: Upgrade asphalt paths to concrete and address deferred maintenance
F <i>Development</i>	McWilliams Neighborhood Park: Replace basketball courts and outdated playground equipment
G <i>Development</i>	Fire Station 21: Refurbish kitchen space
H <i>Development</i>	South Cherry Creek Transfer Station: Address deferred maintenance
I <i>Development</i>	Buchtel and Colorado Boulevard Intersection and Colorado Station Bike/Pedestrian Access Improvements: Reconstruct intersection and add protected bike lanes and pedestrian safety features
J <i>Development</i>	Monaco Parkway Bridge Over Cherry Creek: Replace the bridge
