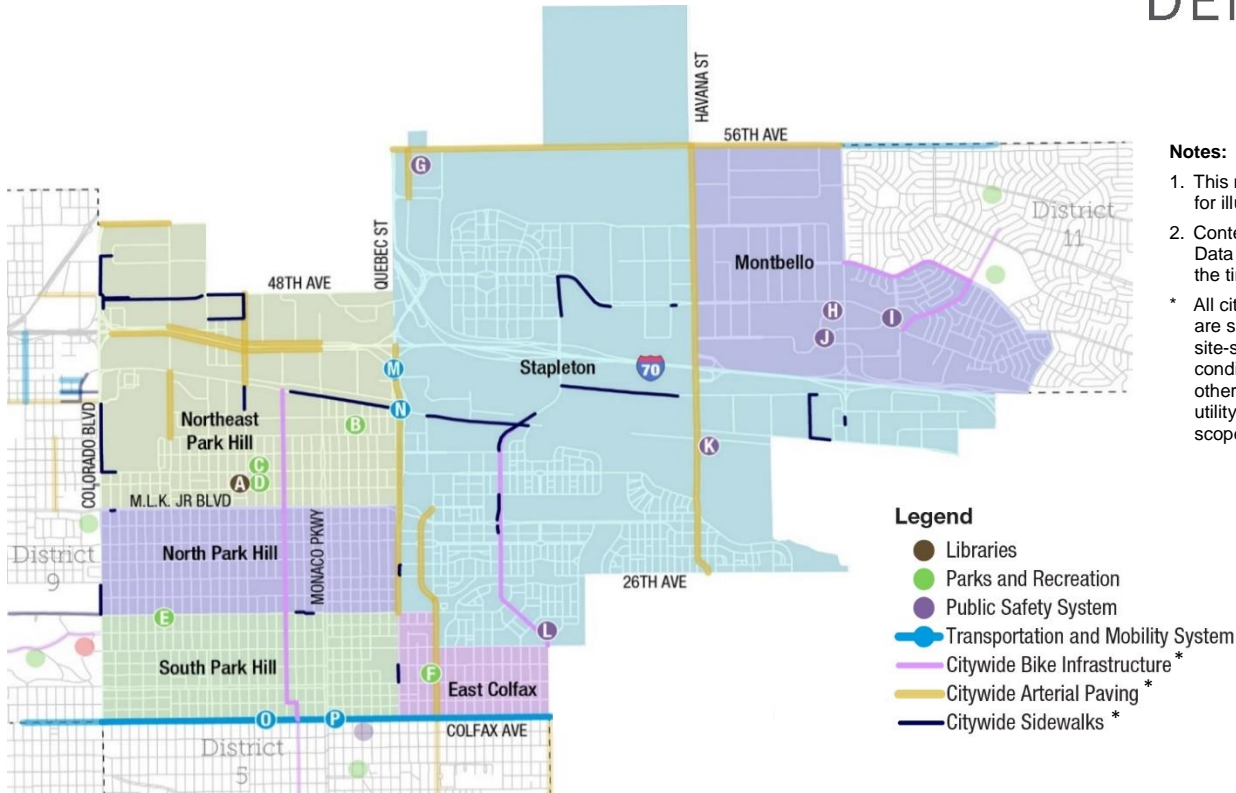


ELEVATE DENVER BOND PROGRAM COUNCIL DISTRICT 8 PROJECTS

D	Development Hiawatha Davis Recreation Center: Address deferred maintenance
E	Development Ferguson Neighborhood Park: Replace outdated playground equipment
F	Development McNichols Neighborhood Park: Replace outdated playground equipment
G	Development Roslyn Complex Upgrades: Replace outdated equipment and renovate
H	Development Arie P. Taylor Municipal Center: Replace roof
