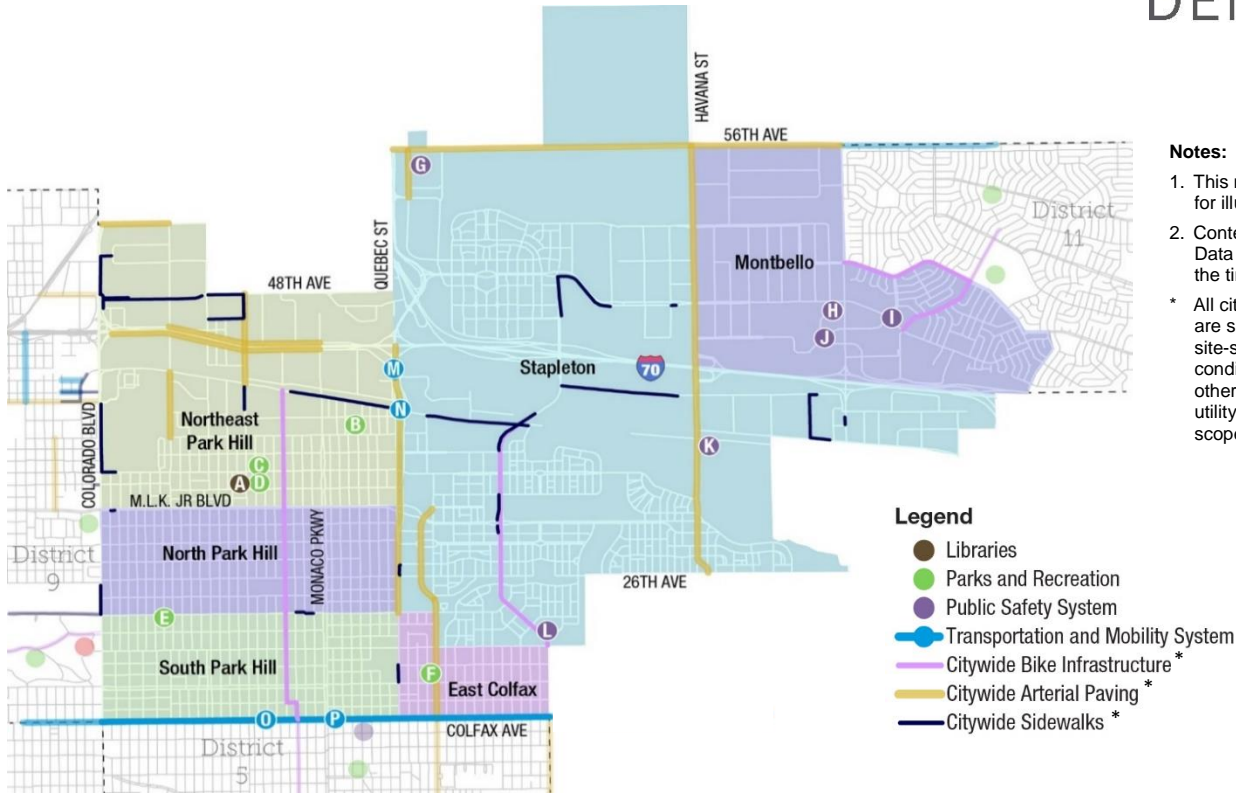


ELEVATE DENVER BOND PROGRAM COUNCIL DISTRICT 8 PROJECTS
