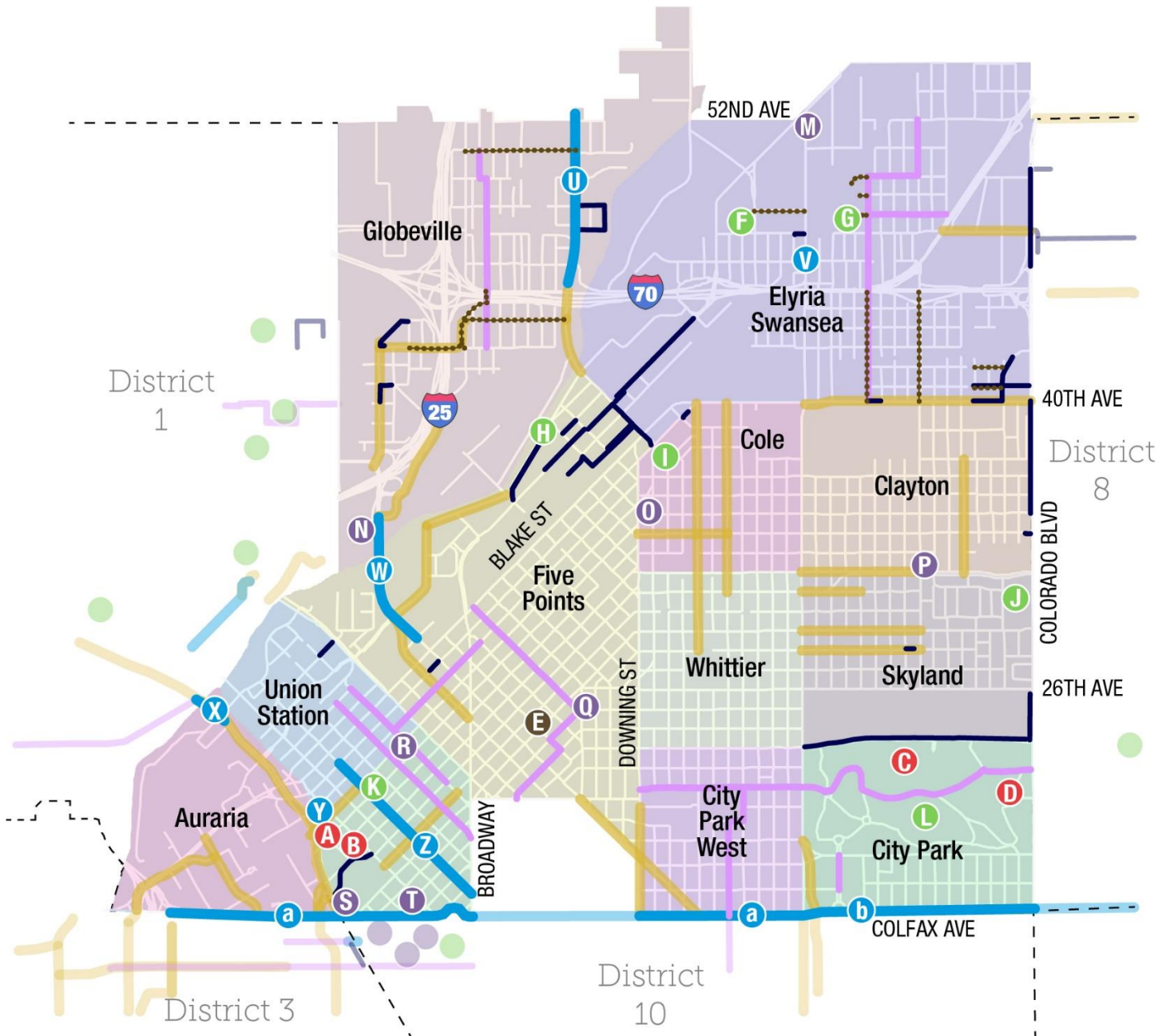

A <i>Design</i>	Bonfils Theater Complex: Renovate the Stage Theater and office/administrative areas
B <i>Development</i>	Buell Theater: Renovate the lobby and restrooms, improve ADA access, and other improvements
C <i>Design</i>	Denver Zoo: Build new animal hospital and purchase equipment
D <i>Design</i>	Denver Museum of Nature and Science: Address deferred maintenance
E <i>Development</i>	Blair-Caldwell Library: Replace outdated equipment, renovate space, restore and enhance landscaping, sidewalks, and parking lots
F <i>Development</i>	Elyria Neighborhood Park: Replace basketball courts
G <i>Development</i>	Swansea Recreation Center: Reconstruct the pool and address deferred maintenance
H <i>Development</i>	Arkins Court Promenade: Create a multimodal promenade
I <i>Development</i>	St. Charles Neighborhood Park and Recreation Center: Upgrade aging playground equipment and address recreation center deferred maintenance
J <i>Development</i>	Boyd Neighborhood Park: Upgrade asphalt paths to concrete
K <i>Development</i>	Skyline Park: Redesign and refurbish park facilities
L <i>Development</i>	City Park: Replace aging playground equipment

Q <i>Development</i>	Fire Station 3: Refurbish kitchen space

T <i>Development</i>	Minoru Yasui Building: Address deferred maintenance

Z <i>Development</i>	16th Street Mall: Reconstruct the mall to improve sidewalks, transit way, and streetscaping
a <i>Development</i>	Colfax Bus Rapid Transit (BRT): Add exclusive bus lanes, new transit stops, and other improvements to allow the BRT to operate efficiently and effectively
b <i>Development</i>	Colfax Corridor Improvements: Improve pedestrian and bicycle safety
