

**\*7. State of Emergency Declaration**

WHEREAS people, property and the environment are at risk due to the continued civil disturbance related to the George Floyd protests with resulting damage to people and property in the City and County of Denver, described in the following paragraphs;

AND WHEREAS the risks posed by this continued intentional hazard/threat requires early warning for and preparation by those potentially or actually affected; or protection of infrastructure, property, possessions, or the environment; as well as prompt coordination of response and recovery actions, or special regulations of access, activities, persons, property, or the environment in order to protect the health, safety, or welfare of people, to limit damage to property, or the environment within the City and County of Denver described herein;

I HEREBY DECLARE, pursuant to the State Constitution, the Colorado Disaster Emergency Act (C.R.S. 24-33.5-701), the Charter and Ordinances of the City and County of Denver, and Chapter 16 of the Denver Revised Municipal Code that a STATE OF LOCAL EMERGENCY NOW EXISTS and is so ORDERED, authorized, and approved.

BE IT KNOWN THAT the geographic area affected and to which this DECLARATION applies is known as the City and County of Denver.

AND BE IT ALSO KNOWN THAT the Mayor of the City and County of Denver hereby advises the Governor of the State of Colorado and the population within the aforementioned described area that a STATE OF LOCAL EMERGENCY exists and that the Mayor of the City and County of Denver may exercise some or all of the powers allowed by the State Constitution, the Colorado Disaster Emergency Act (C.R.S. 24-33.5-701), the Charter and Ordinances of the City and County of Denver, and Chapter 16 of the Denver Revised Municipal Code during this STATE OF LOCAL EMERGENCY.

AND BE IT ALSO KNOW THAT this DECLARATION authorizes the City and County of Denver, its residents, and its businesses to apply for assistance from the State of Colorado, the Federal Government, or other available resources.

AND BE IT ALSO KNOW THAT this DECLARATION and STATE OF LOCAL EMERGENCY will remain in force from May 30, 2020 to June 7, 2020 at 11:59 p.m. This DECLARATION will remain in effect for 7 days unless renewed or rescinded earlier.
