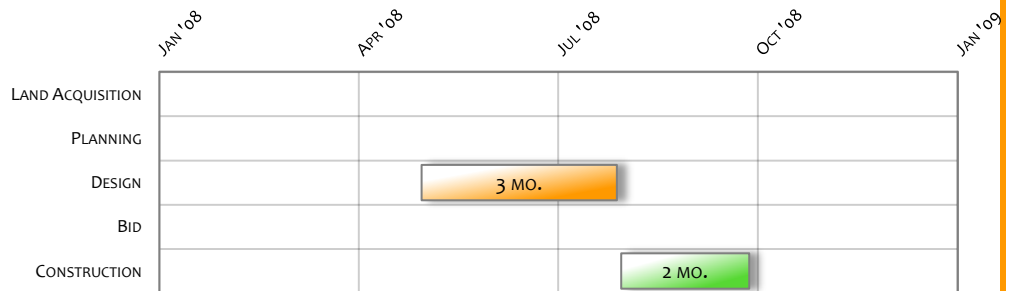


Project Overview

Project Scope

Renovation work at the Northeast Child Care Center (operated by Mile High Montessori) focused on energy efficiency measures and ADA upgrades intended to bring the facility into compliance with current building standards. Most notably, the entire structure was wrapped in energy-efficient insulation, which was then covered in new exterior siding painted with colorful murals. The building's original aluminum-framed windows were replaced with double-pane glass, providing further insulation. In addition, a new handicapped entry ramp was constructed and the restroom upgraded to reflect current ADA standards. Other minor improvements addressed the user experience and included the lowering of countertops, the installation of additional cabinet space, and minor interior space reconfigurations.
