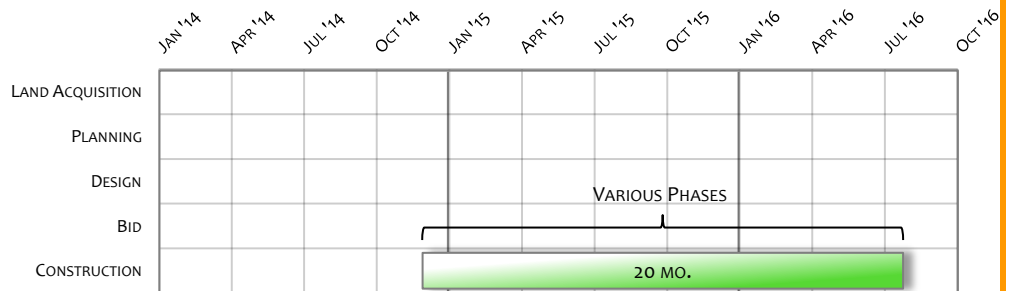

Project Overview

Project Scope

Improvements within the Denver Performing Arts Complex Galleria included replacement of the concrete pedestrian ramp at the Galleria's 14th Street entrance, demolition of a portion of existing concrete stairs, construction of an improved concrete retaining wall, installation of cane-detection railings around existing stairs, installation of new handrails, additional accessibility improvements, repairs to existing pavement, and updates to electrical and lighting systems within the adjacent Sculpture Park. Existing lighting on the lower terrace was replaced with higher efficiency fixtures, reducing electricity consumption and enhancing pedestrian safety.

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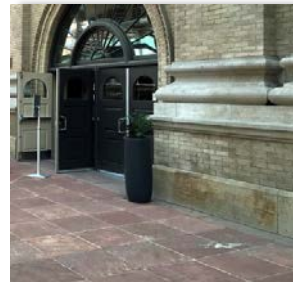

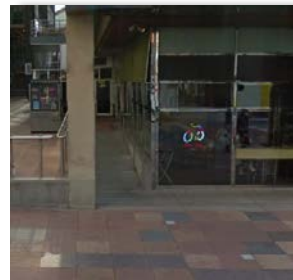
