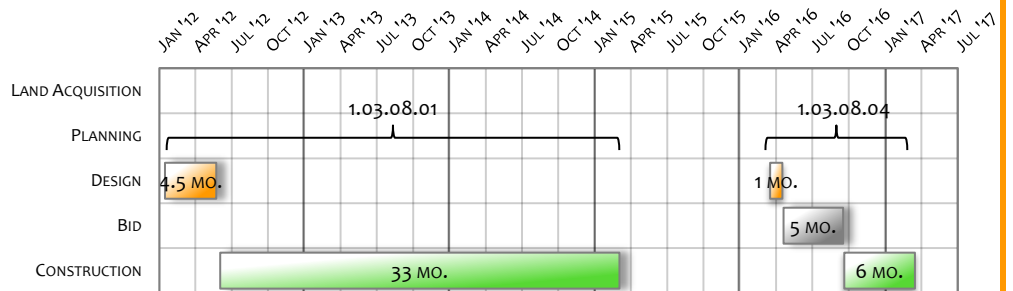


Project Overview

Project Scope

Rehabilitation of the Richard T. Castro Building included replacement of the outdated badge access system, updates to the video surveillance system, reconstruction of exterior stairs, retrofit of lighting systems, updates to interior finishes including new carpet and paint, structural improvements within the parking garage, and replacement of the building's membrane roofing system. The project was completed in two phases: the majority of work was performed through a series of on-call work orders beginning in 2012 and extending into 2015, whereas the roof replacement was procured via hard bid and completed in early 2017.
