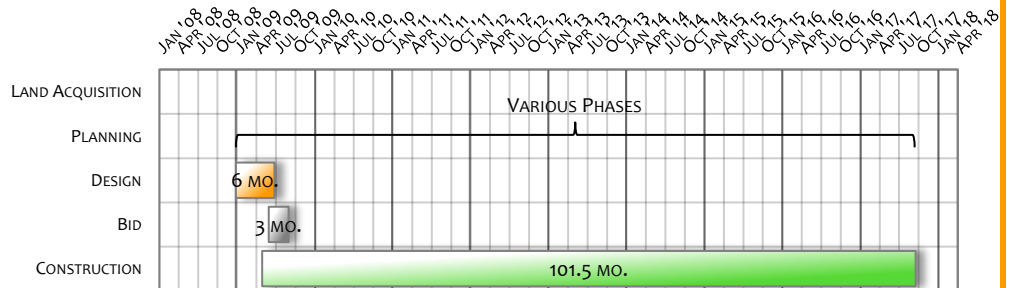


## Project Overview

### Project Scope

The Better Denver Bond Program funded improvements along roughly a dozen of the City's regional trails, from the replacement of aging pavement and bridge systems to the installation of new user amenities including garbage/recycling receptacles, benches and picnic tables. The Confluence Park Trail Improvements project partially funded a complete redesign of Shoemaker Plaza along the west bank of the South Platte River, the initial phase of Denver Parks & Recreation's River Vision Phase II master plan. Together, these improvements will enhance the experience of trail users for years to come.
