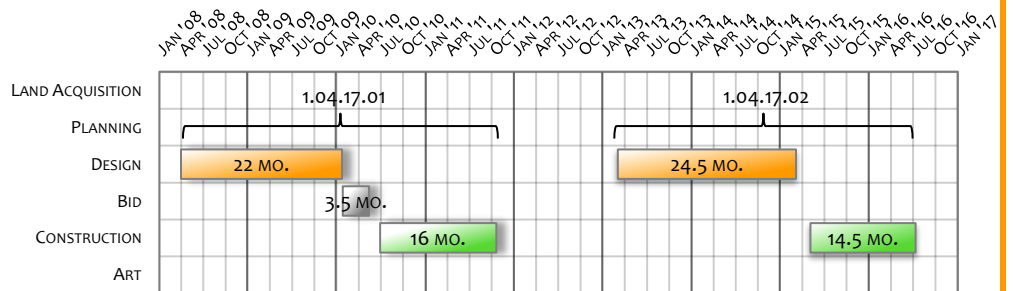


Project Overview

Project Scope

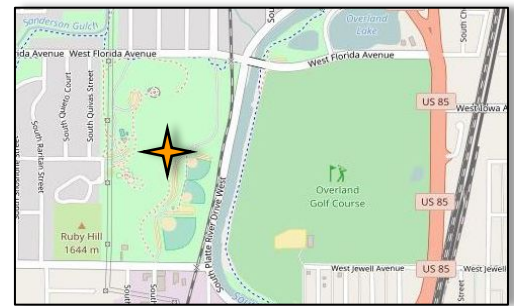
The Ruby Hill Park Improvements project was comprised of two phases: the first included updates to playground areas, site furnishings, walkways, parking areas, and construction of a new picnic shelter; the second included construction of a 7.5-acre mountain bike park complete with slopestyle course, dirt jumps, pump tracks, and a skills course. These new and improved park features complement additional Better Denver projects within Ruby Hill Park, from irrigation improvements and new public restrooms to the design and construction of Denver's very own Levitt Pavilion, an outdoor performance venue offering 50 free concerts per year. Together, these projects have helped to transform the park from an underutilized public space to one of Denver's premier outdoor destinations.
