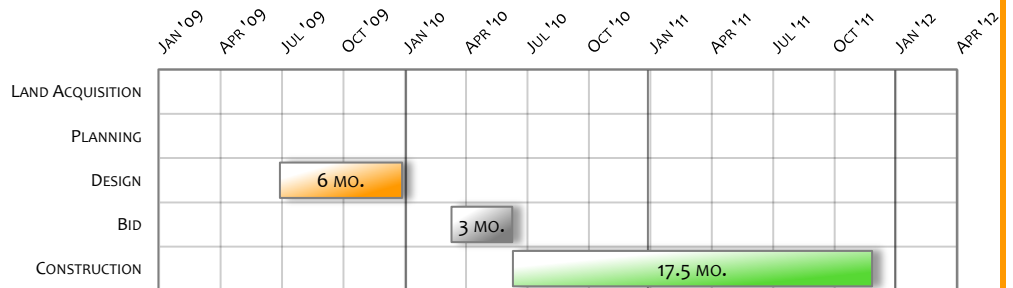


Project Overview

Project Scope

The Sloan's Lake Park Improvements project included the following primary scope elements: renovation of the jetty and marina shoreline with an enhanced promenade, new irrigation pumps within a new pumphouse building and renovation of restrooms inside the existing boathouse. More specifically, work included demolition, earthwork, drainage improvements, shoreline protection in the form of riprap and concrete retaining walls, concrete seat walls, concrete flatwork, crusher-fines paving, metal railings, boardwalk, site furnishings, seeding, sodding, planting, improvements to building electrical and HVAC systems, installation of a new irrigation pump station, new restroom fixtures, site electrical and irrigation upgrades, and ADA improvements.
