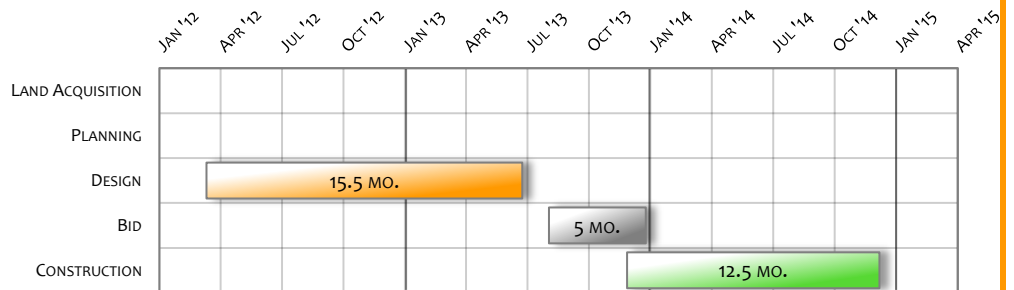


Project Overview

Project Scope

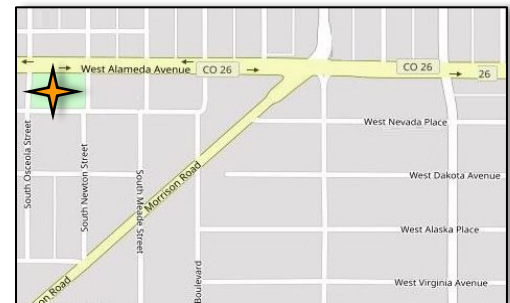
Located along West Alameda Avenue just a few blocks west of Morrison Road, the New Westwood Neighborhood Park is the first new park to be built in this community in more than 30 years. Previously home to mobile homes and a bar, the new park provides a vibrant and active community open space that includes a playground and interactive water feature, turf areas for fitness/sport activities, a picnic shelter, and new landscaping. Its location, situated on a hill rising up from West Alameda, also provides spectacular views of the Denver skyline. Ultimately, Cuatro Vientos/Four Winds Park was chosen as the name by the local community because they felt it was representative of the many different cultures that make up the Westwood community.
