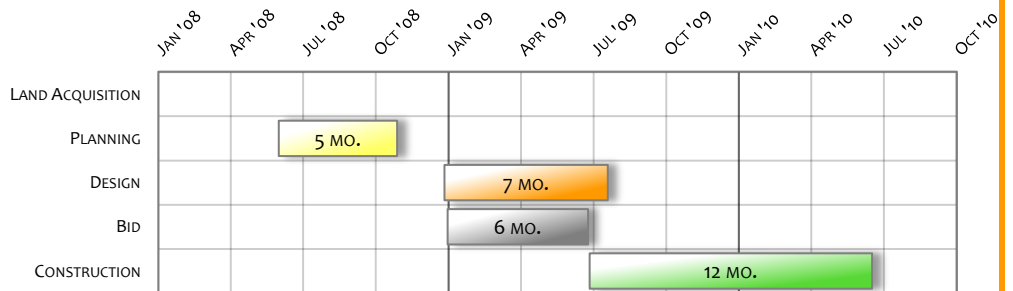

Project Scope

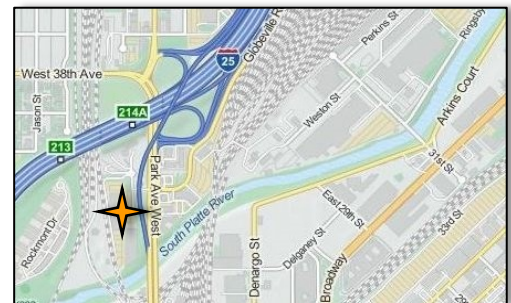
The Better Denver Bond Program funded enhancements to public safety facilities including the creation of a new, multi-purpose Denver Police campus on Park Avenue West. The project involved design and construction of a new training facility, firing range and parking garage, as well as the complete renovation of an existing warehouse structure which now houses Denver's Traffic Investigations Bureau and Traffic Operations Bureau under one roof. Combined, the two facilities provide the Denver Police Department with nearly 50,000 square feet of additional space. The new campus offers state-of-the-art training facilities intended to increase the efficiency of police operations and the site's close proximity to downtown Denver and major highways improves police services and enhances public safety through reduced response times.

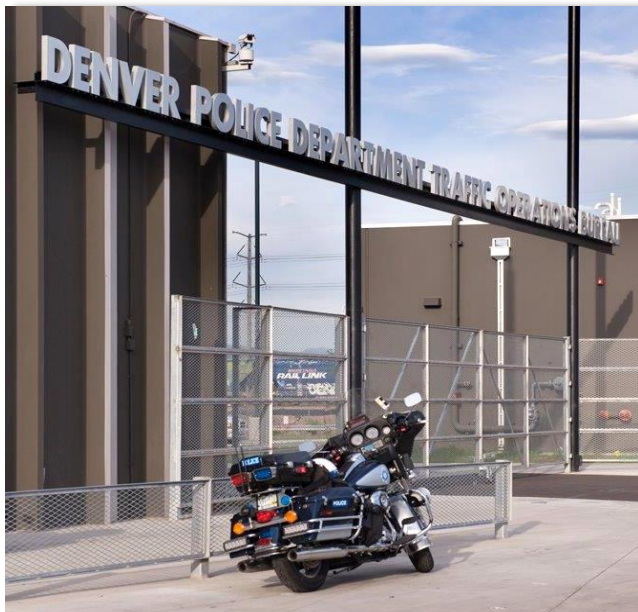

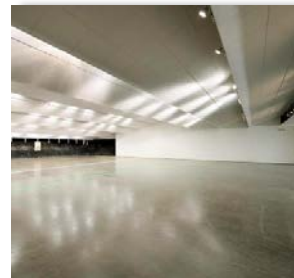
