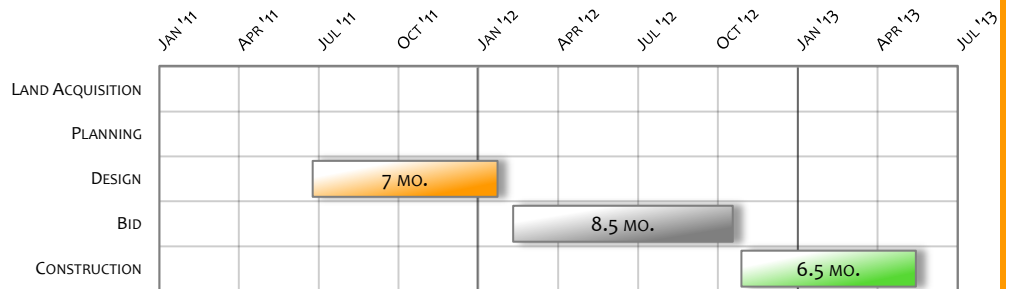


Project Overview

Project Scope

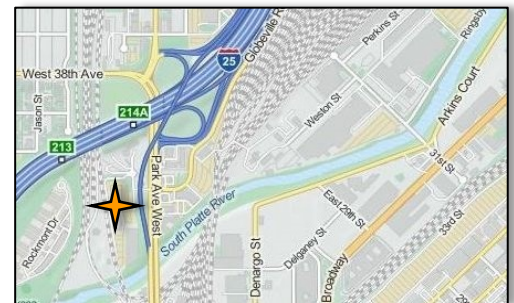
Design and construction of Denver Police Department's new Command Vehicle Garage was made possible with the redeployment of savings realized throughout the course of previous Better Denver Bond projects. The new building, located adjacent to the recently completed Firing Range and Traffic Operations Facility at Denver Police Department's Park Avenue West campus, is roughly 7,000 square feet and includes seven 60-foot bays for secure storage of command, SWAT and bomb squad vehicles. Much like the various other police units now at this location, state-of-the-art facilities will increase the efficiency of police operations and close proximity to downtown Denver and major highways will enhance public safety through a reduction in overall response times.

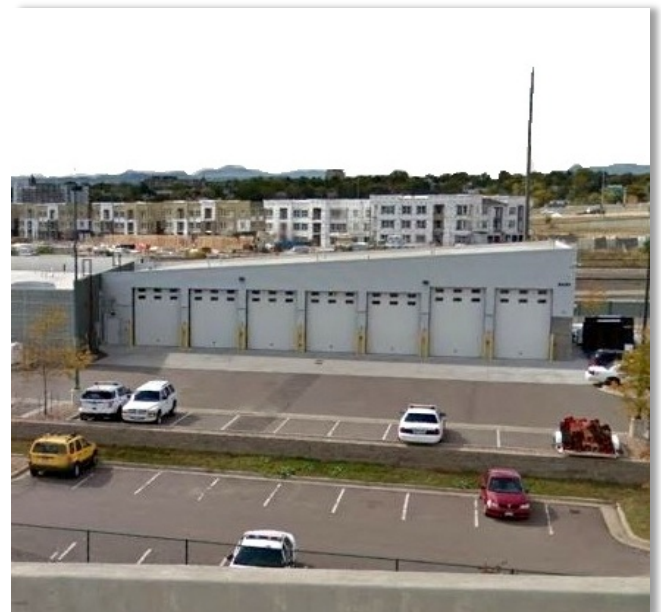
