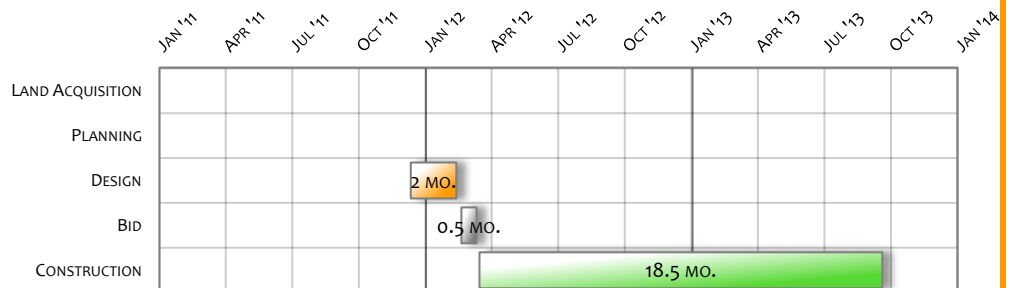


Project Overview

Project Scope

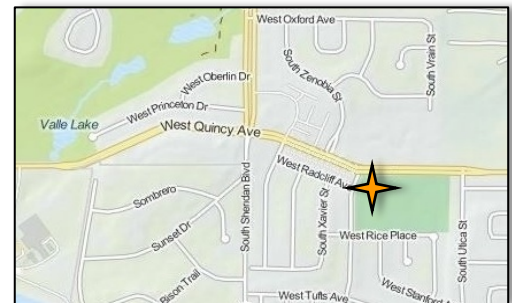
Renovation of Denver Fire Department's Station Number 28 was made possible with the redeployment of savings realized throughout the course of previous Better Denver Bond projects. Renovation work was comprised of the following primary activities: rehabilitation/replacement of aging HVAC system components; associated improvements to ductwork and finishes; minor upgrades to the building's existing electrical systems; as well as inspection, testing and abatement of asbestos-containing materials.
