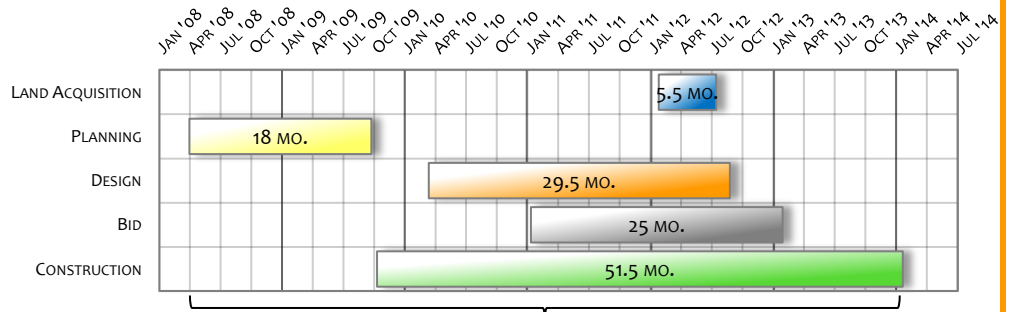


Project Overview

Project Scope

The Colfax & 14th Avenue Improvements project included right-of-way enhancements along West Colfax and West 14th Avenues between Speer Boulevard and Broadway, related improvements to Bannock Street between West Colfax and West 14th Avenues, and reconfiguration of the West Colfax Avenue and Galapago Street intersection. A total of three intersections were repaved with concrete, resulting in a longer lasting road surface. Medians along West Colfax Avenue were removed and reconstructed with raised planting beds and decorative granite monuments. Pedestrian safety and connectivity were enhanced throughout the corridor via upgraded curb ramps, the creation of bulb-outs at select intersections and restriped crosswalks. Existing bike lanes were extended along West 14th Avenue and Bannock Street. And street lights along West Colfax and West 14th Avenues were upgraded to the curvilinear style to match the City's current standard.

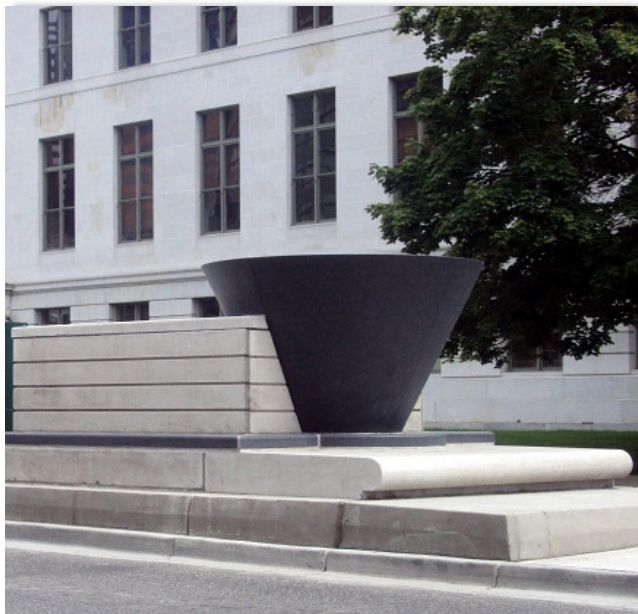
