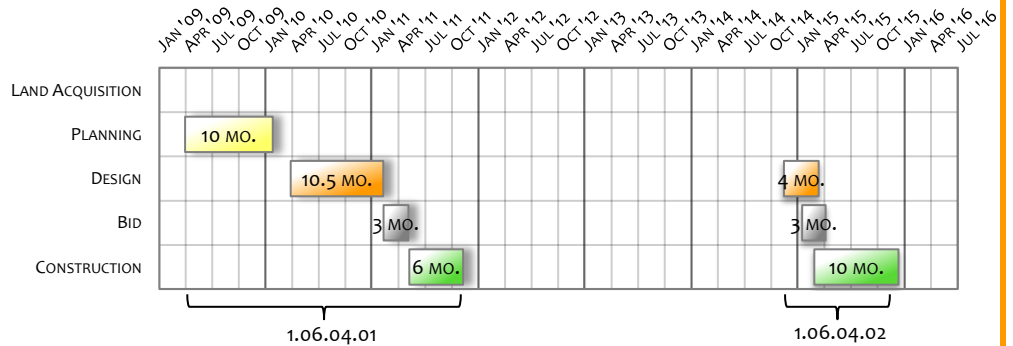

Project Overview

Project Scope

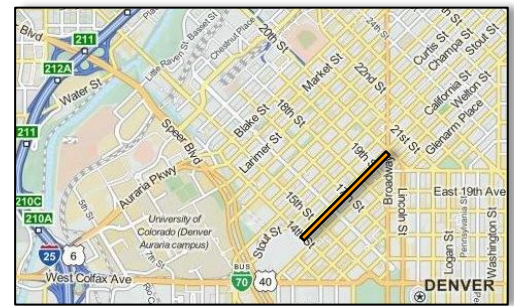
This project comprised streetscape improvements within the California Street right-of-way, mainly between 14th and 17th Streets, aimed at providing a consistent pedestrian environment leading toward the new Colorado Convention Center. These improvements were designed to be consistent with previous California Street right-of-way enhancements in front of the Denver Dry Building and Hyatt Regency Hotel. The new streetscape design was also intended to create better connections or buffers, as appropriate, between the sidewalk and adjacent uses such as Light Rail stops, taxi loading, patios, and parking. Improvements comprised the installation of new sidewalk materials including decorative grey concrete pavers, granite curbs and granite benches; new trees and tree-well banner poles; and new pedestrian lighting fixtures and accent lighting.

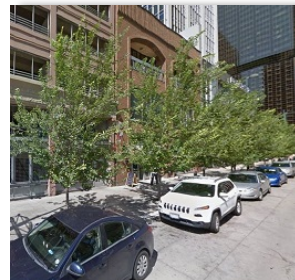
