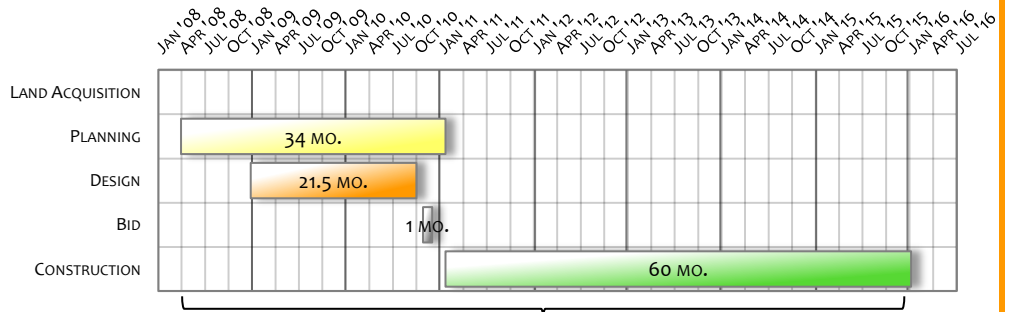

Project Overview

Project Scope

This project consisted of the widening of Federal Boulevard from West Alameda Avenue to 6th Avenue and the reconstruction of existing US 6 bridges over Bryant Street, the Platte River, I-25, and the Burlington Northern and Santa Fe Railway line. Improvements ranged from reconstruction and widening of Federal Boulevard from five lanes to six lanes to associated utility and stormwater improvements in nearby Barnum Park. Design, construction and project management were performed by the Colorado Department of Transportation with support from local agencies including the City and County of Denver (CCD). CCD managed the significant right-of-way acquisition work needed prior to design and construction.

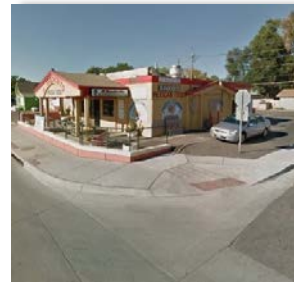
