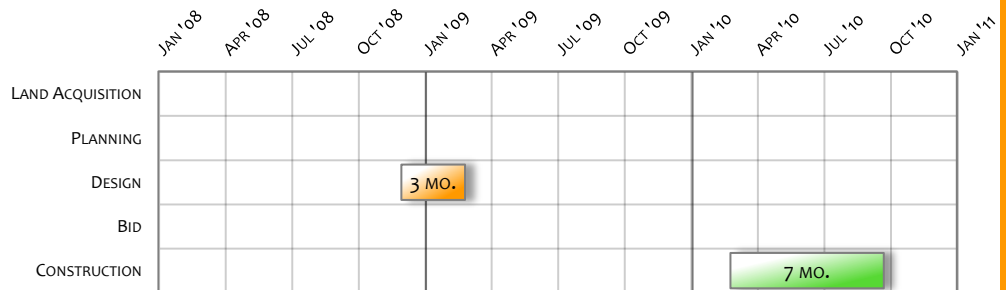


Project Overview
