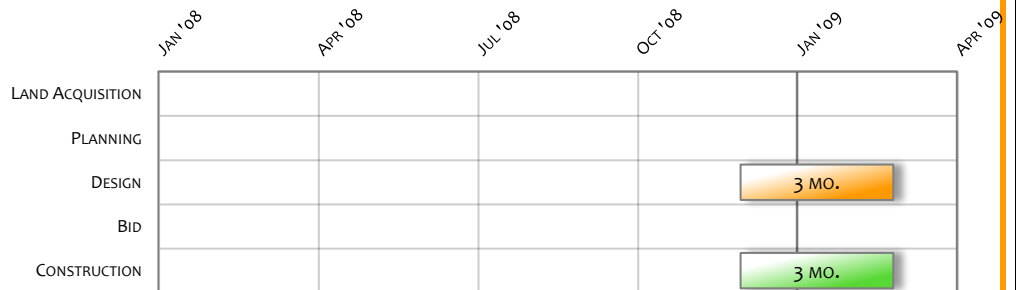

### Project Scope

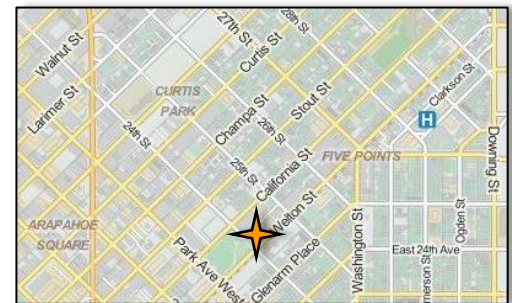

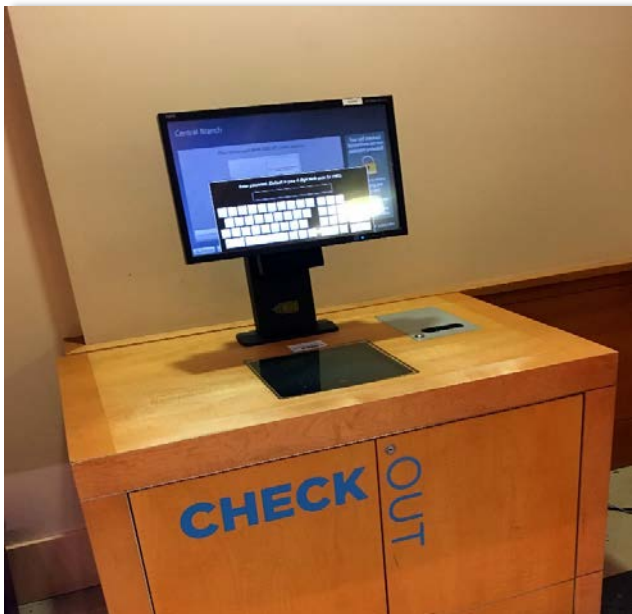
