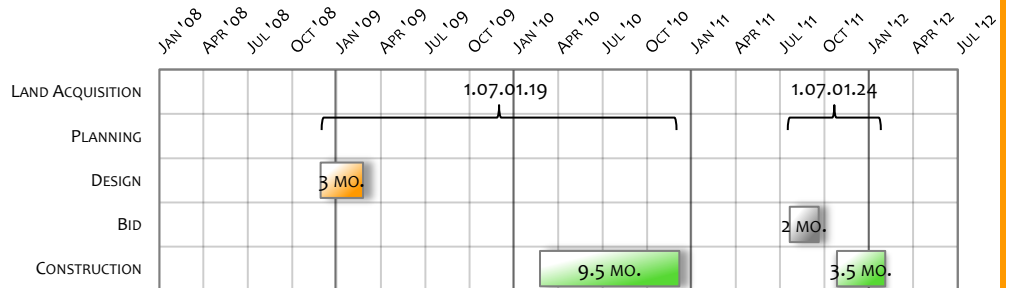

Renovations Project Overview

Project Scope

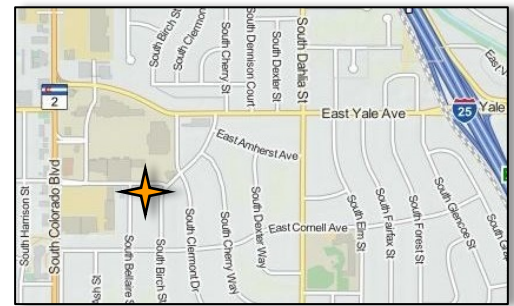
Renovation work at the Ross-University Hills Branch of the Denver Public Library comprised upgrades to electrical and lighting systems, updates to interior finishes and furnishings, reconfiguration of the building's existing book drop to accommodate a new automated book sorter, procurement and installation of self-check stations, as well as installation of a radio frequency identification (RFID) system. Together, the self-check and RFID technologies allow for automated self-check of library media and provide numerous benefits including improved circulation/collection management, reduced theft of library materials, increased efficiency of library staff, and an enhanced customer experience.
