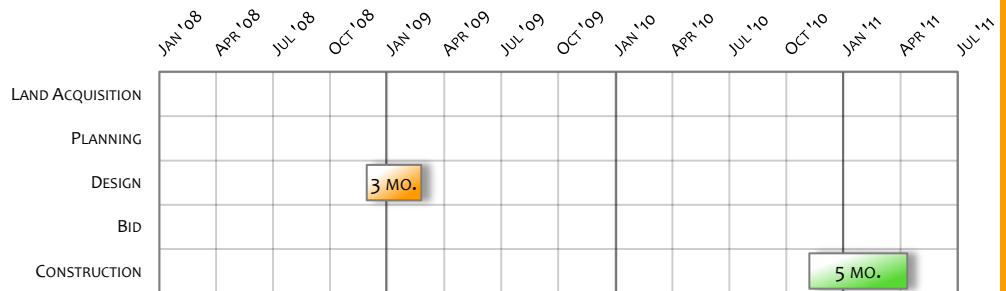

Project Scope

Renovation work at the Virginia Village Branch of the Denver Public Library comprised upgrades to fire protection, electrical, mechanical, and plumbing systems, reconfiguration of interior spaces to enhance circulation, accessibility improvements, updates to finishes and furnishings, technology enhancements, procurement and installation of self-check stations, as well as installation of a radio frequency identification (RFID) system. Together, the self-check and RFID technologies allow for automated self-check of library media and provide numerous benefits including improved circulation/collection management, reduced theft of library materials, increased efficiency of library staff, and an enhanced customer experience.

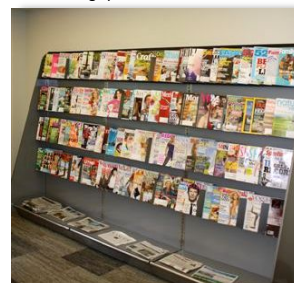
