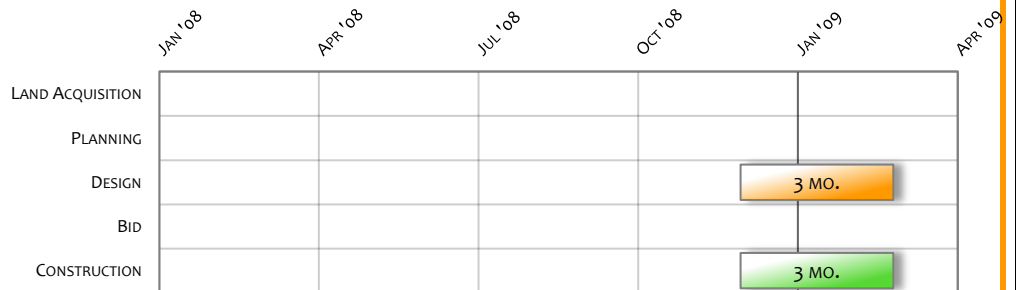


Project Overview
