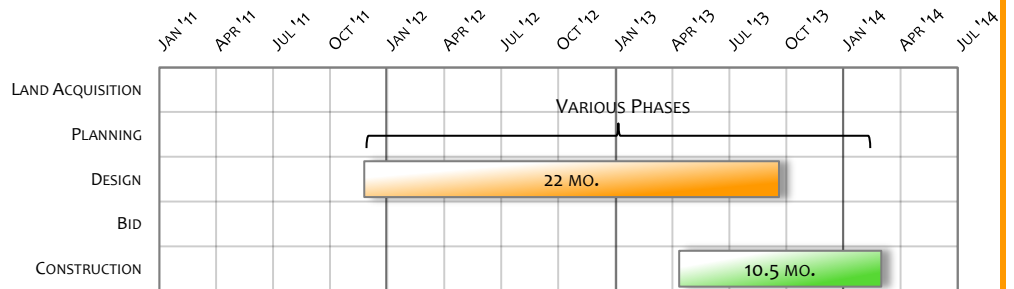

## Project Overview

### Project Scope

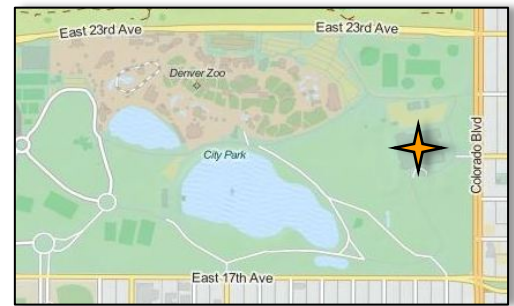
The Denver Museum of Nature & Science Road Improvements project included realignment of the Museum's southern access road and reconfiguration of the entrance intersection west of Montview Boulevard and Colorado Boulevard. The Museum's existing southern access road and large group entrance were substantially modified by the addition of the Morgridge Family Exploration Center, with areas of the road and adjacent meadow utilized for material laydown and staging during construction. This road was realigned to increase the size of City Park's East Meadow, and dedicated parking areas were added for school buses and park visitors. In addition, the Museum entrance intersection at Colorado Boulevard was converted into a roundabout to enhance pedestrian safety and traffic flow.
