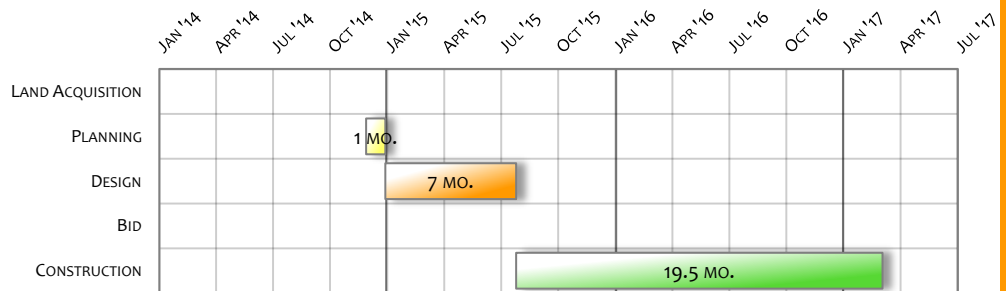


## Project Overview

### Project Scope

The Denver Zoo Large Carnivores Building project comprised design and construction of a roughly 2,500 square-foot facility including two off-exhibit yards and one large exhibit yard for the outdoor viewing of Amur (Siberian) tigers. Collectively known as The Edge, these new facilities also include an improved viewing area with a perforated wall and overhead connecting bridges, enabling visitors to interact with the animals up-close. Specialty cagework inside the building allows zoo personnel to manage multiple pairs of tigers as well as their offspring. The new outdoor spaces, occupying nearly a full acre, increase the tigers' existing space by almost 50 percent and include elements of the animals' natural habitat.

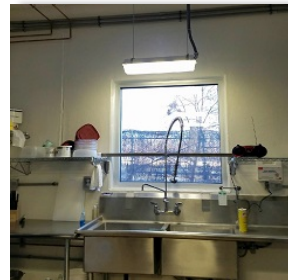

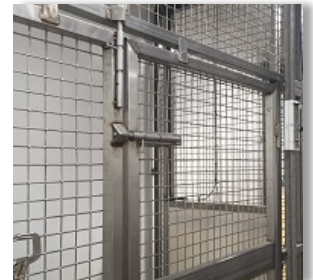

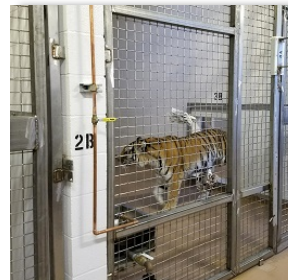
