This section contains a list of equipment used by the Semi-Tractor Trailer Operator classification.

This classification is in the Maintenance and Operations pay schedule at the 616-J pay grade. Incumbents operate a semi-tractor trailer to transport large and heavy vehicles, construction equipment, and hauling materials from one location to another, requiring a high degree of skill in loading and unloading cargo and materials, and performs light to heavy physical labor.

Examples of equipment include: semi-tractor trailers, lowboy, box, or hauler.

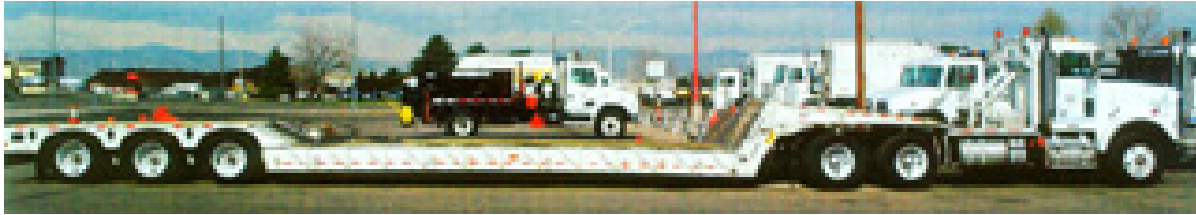
