



PROCESS FOR MODIFICATIONS TO EXISTING APPROVED OR ADDITION OF NEW SOLVENTS FOR EXTRACTION PROCESSES

In accordance with the Denver Fire Code, permits are required for extraction processes within the City and County of Denver. These processes, as well as the equipment and materials used shall be reviewed and have construction and operational permits issued prior to commencing operations.

Once an approval is issued for an extraction process, equipment, and/ or materials used, any modifications or additions to any of these must be submitted for review and approval.

If a solvent is being added or changed, or a process has been modified or updated, please submit the following via email to DFDMarijuanaEnforcement@denvergov.org with a copy to phicomments@denvergov.org of the following:

- Letter/report, signed and sealed by a Colorado licensed design professional, reviewing the modified process and/or solvent and justifying that the modification complies with Denver Fire Code requirements.
- A copy of updated Standard Operating Procedures
- Completed Extraction Application [Denver Fire Permits](#)
- Completed Solvent Storage and Use Application(s) [Denver Fire Permits](#)

A plan review fee of \$100 will be applicable to all extraction modifications and hazardous materials reviews for revised or new operational permits for extraction processes.

All operational permit fees apply.

Once the information has been submitted, the applicant will be notified via email with comments or an approval notification with an invoice to pay for permits.
