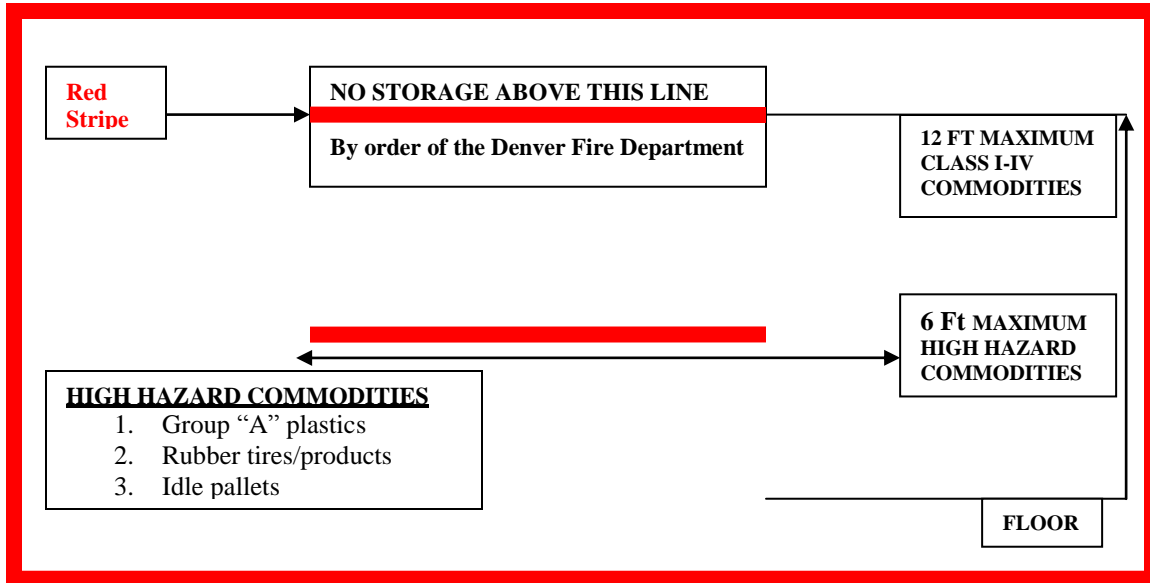


HEIGHT RESTRICTED FACILITY AGREEMENT FOR CLASS I-IV AND HIGH HAZARD COMMODITIES

PER DENVER FIRE CODE CHAPTER 23, YOUR BUILDING IS LIMITED TO THE 12 FOOT MAXIMUM STORAGE HEIGHT FOR CLASS I-IV COMMODITIES AND 6 FOOT ON HIGH-HAZARD COMMODITIES BASED ON THE DFC TABLE 2306.2 GENERAL FIRE PROTECTION AND LIFE SAFETY REQUIREMENTS.



I, the responsible party for this building, understand that a visual method of indicating the maximum allowable storage height is required to be posted throughout all areas meeting the description of high-piled capable storage areas described in **DFC 2305.6** and that my fire safety system limits my storage to a **maximum height of 12 feet** for **Class I-IV commodities** only. **High hazard commodities such as Group "A" plastics, idle pallet and rubber tires are limited to a maximum of 6 feet.** Failure to maintain these height restrictions on subsequent inspections will result in a full compliance upgrade to my buildings fire safety system based on the **IFC TABLE 2306.2 GENERAL FIRE PROTECTION AND LIFE SAFETY REQUIREMENTS**, as defined online at:
