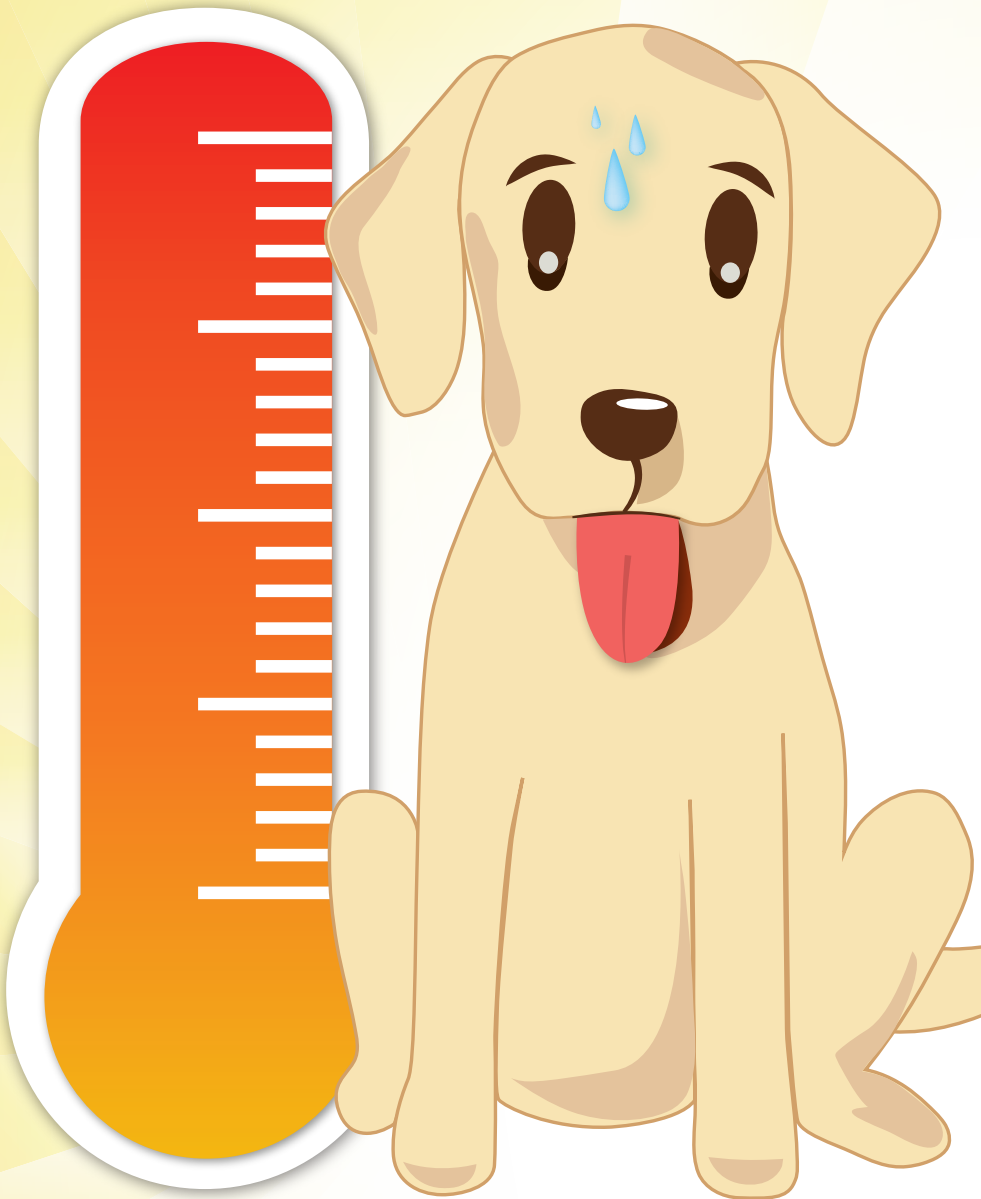


NEVER LEAVE A DOOG IN A HOT CAR
