

TEMPORARY MORTGAGE ASSISTANCE

If you are experiencing financial hardship (job loss, layoff, reduced hours), you may be eligible for the city's Temporary Mortgage Assistance Program.

**Provides up to two months or \$5,000 maximum
for qualified Denver residents.**

Who qualifies?

- ✓ Homeowners who are facing hardship due to unexpected changes in their employment status – including furlough, temporary layoff or significant reduction of hours worked.
- ✓ Home must be located within the City and County of Denver, and homeowner must reside in the home as their primary residence.
- ✓ Total household income cannot exceed 120% of the Area Median Income (AMI).

Up to \$75,600 for a single-person household, \$86,400 for a two-person household, \$97,200 for a three-person household, \$107,880 for a four-person household, \$116,520 for a five-person household, and \$125,160 for a six-person household.
