DUMPSTER & CONTAINER INFORMATION SHEET

Permitting process for containers (roll-offs, dumpsters, and other types of containers) placed in the public Right-of-Way during construction or demolition. For more information see the web site.

Right of Way Street Occupancy Permit is required:

- Required prior to placement of any container within the Right-of-Way
- Must be obtained by the dumpster/container company placing the container
- Permit must be visible on the property.
- Permit will specify Start and End dates

Submittal Process:

- Right of Way Street Occupancy Permits are obtained by the dumpster/container company from Public Works Permit Operations.
- Dumpster / Container companies must be registered with the Public Works Finance & Administration prior to applying for a permit. A license number will be issued after submittal of the [Dumpster & Container Billing Authorization Form](#).
- Applications for a permit should be emailed separately to pwpermits@denvergov.org with the **COMPANY NAME, ADDRESS OF PLACEMENT, REQUESTED START DATE OF PERMIT** in the subject line. Applications need to be received electronically in the interactive form in which they are provided. Applications received after 4:00 pm will be processed on the following business day.
- Applicant shall allow 5 days for permit processing. Issues that may increase permit review time are: incomplete or unclear application, placement does not meet the required sight distance criteria as defined in the American Association of State Highway and Transportation Officials (AASHTO), and/or the classification of the right-of-way.
- If there are Parking Meters at the location, they must be identified on the application.

Additional Information - Dumpsters/Containers:

- All dumpsters/containers placed within the Right-of-Way are subject to inspection by City Inspectors.
- Must have a minimum 6 inch wide by 4 foot long strip of reflective tape placed vertically on each corner or four vertical panel barricades with flashing lights must be placed on the street side of the container. (Placement of the barricades is to be at each end and evenly spaced in the middle.)
- May be placed in the public Right-of-Way for a maximum of 180 days in a 12 month period.

Placement:

- Containers must be placed and fit within a parking lane and be a minimum of 20 feet from any corner, alley, or entrance. At no time can a container occupy or impede a sidewalk, tree lawn, travel lane, no parking zone, temporary loading zone, or alley.
- Each RSOP allows up to 40 linear feet of parking lane, no more than 2 dumpsters/containers per application.
- If a dumpster/container requires metered spaces, two parking meters must be submitted on the application.
- Dumpsters/containers may be placed in the public Right-of-Way for a maximum of 180 days in a 12 month period.

Dumpster & Container

Application for Right of Way Street Occupancy Permit

Email applications to: pwpermits@denvergov.org. (Please include **COMPANY NAME/ SITE ADDRESS/DATE NEEDED** in the subject line of the email to speed up the permitting process.)

- A Street Occupancy Permit must be obtained prior to placing any item in the right-of-way.
- The permit must be visible on the property.
- The dumpster/container owner's name and contact information must be clearly visible on the item.
- Applicant shall allow 5 days for permit processing. Issues that may increase permit review time are: incomplete or unclear application, placement does not meet the required sight distance criteria as defined in the American Association of State Highway and Transportation Officials (AASHTO), and/or the classification of the right-of-way.
- Dumpster/container must be at least 20 feet from any corner, alley, or entrance and fit within the parking lane.
- All applicants must be registered with Denver Public Works Finance and Administration. Accounts must be paid up to date in order for permits to be processed. *No refunds or credits for permits that have been processed.*
- Dumpster/container must have a minimum 6 inch wide by 4 foot long strip of reflective tape placed vertically on each corner or four vertical panel barricades with flashing lights must be placed on the street side of the container.
- Dumpster/container cannot be placed in the right-of-way for more than 180 days out of any consecutive 12 month period.
